



THREE MILLION HOLIDAY LIGHTS, OUTDOOR SKATING RINK HELP KICK-OFF INAUGURAL “LIGHTS AND ICE” HOLIDAY CELEBRATION STARTING TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 22

Grand new holiday tradition includes spectacular displays at Tulalip Resort Casino, Quil Ceda Creek Casino and Tulalip Bingo & Slots, presented by Quil Ceda Village

TULALIP, Wash. (November 22, 2022) – A spectacular display of more than three million holiday lights brightening the winter night sky and a seasonal outdoor ice rink are featured attractions of the inaugural “Lights and Ice” festivities kicking off Tuesday, November 22. Encompassing spectacular lighting displays at Tulalip Resort Casino (adorned with 1.4 million lights alone), Quil Ceda Creek Casino, Tulalip Bingo & Slots, Quil Ceda Village, and the Tulalip Retail Center, “Lights and Ice” is presented by Quil Ceda Village at Tulalip, WA. Free to the public, the displays are located along Interstate 5 and accessible at westbound exits 200 or 202.

The debut of this holiday tradition includes an ice rink at Tulalip Amphitheatre surrounded by a display of more than 700,000 lights. Presented by Blue Line Sports and Entertainment, the rink will be open daily through January 8, 2022. Hours each week are Monday through Thursday, 4 to 10 p.m., and Friday through Sunday, 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. Tickets for skating (with skate rentals included) are \$15 for adults and \$12 for children (12 years old and under). Tickets can be purchased at the rink or in advance at <https://tulalipice.ticketspice.com/tulalip-ice>.

Admission to the Amphitheatre is free, where visitors are encouraged to view the on-the-ice fun. The only cost is for those who wish to skate.

Adding to the family festivities are appearances by “Mr. & Mrs. Claus” and “The Dickens Carolers,” on hand at the Amphitheatre Saturdays and Sundays, 2 to 6 p.m. through January 8. A variety of quality food and crafts vendors will participate in a nearby open-air market, as well.

“We welcome visitors to drive by and view the magical displays at all the properties, stroll the grounds, strap on skates and join the fun as we kick-off this grand new holiday tradition,” said Martin Napeahi, general manager for Quil Ceda Village.
